Cuvée Constantin is a nod to one of the great Flâneurs. In his essay "The Painter of Modern Life", Charles Baudelaire writes of a journalist turned street painter, a fixture on the sprawling promenades of Paris: Constantin Guys. As Constantin would wander the streets, searching for inspiration, our Winemaker, Anthony, walks the cellar to put together this cuvée every year.

TASTING NOTES

Showcasing the masterful blending of our Winemakers, the Cuvée Constantin Chardonnay blends the ripe sun soaked blocks of La Belle Promenade with the leaner more mineral driven rows showcasing a balanced yet bold cuvée that is deeply textured. Aroma and flavors mirror one another and sing of yellow apple, Meyer lemon, a golden kiss of candle wax, honey, and graham cracker with a touch of French and Austrian oak for richness.
